CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

This **Partnership Agreement** is executed on 7th April 2025

BY AND BETWEEN

Coyolia Technologies Ltd, a company organized and existing under Indian Law, registered under the Companies Act, 2013, having its corporate office at 405, Akruvi Nivas, Czech Colony, Sananthnagar, Hyderabad 500 018, India (herein after referred to as “Coyolia”), having software products, AWS cloud services, technical training and related services

AND

Centurion University of Technology and Management (CUTM), Andhra Pradesh having its Corporate Office at Flat No. 501, Akruvi Vijaya Lakshmi Residency, Seethammadara, Visakhapatnam – 530013 is considered to be the **First Party**.

Both Coyolia and CUTM have expressed the need to have synergy for exploring the market and after due discussions, have agreed to jointly collaborate on youth skilling on and courses for employability with technical skills.

The two entities are referred to as “Parties” where relevant.

For furthering this objective, this Agreement presents the broad areas of collaboration as defined below.

BROAD OBJECTIVES:

1. Develop a joint value proposition between CUTM and Coyolia, for impacting the employability of under graduates and development of industry-mapped courses. Coyolia will create new generation job role with KRAs or employment path, through joint research on industry needs. This will cascade to support services such as train the trainer, OEM certification path, content for each course that fits into NSDC framework and NSDC academy provided LMS
2. Collaborate with like-minded partners such as CII, OEMs of technology products for courseware, content, certification and placements. This is to mobilize relevant information from OEMs, open-source software custodians that can be defined into 200-400 hours course structure. This effort shall produce placement and internship [paid] opportunities for 18-25 age group students, as per NSDC regulations’
3. The end goal is to create an ecosystem in states of India for trained undergraduates, who may be absorbed in industry, MSME organizations in full time employment.

AREAS OF COLLABORATION

1. Youth focused skill development courses, employment opportunities and training courses for industry led new jobs, self-employment
2. Develop IPR and apply for joint IPR in case of new solutions
3. Develop short term hybrid, online, remote courses for students/participants
