per private University Act of Andhra Pradesh, having its Corporate Office at Door No.39-33-33,
VUDA Colony Phase 1, Madhavadhara, Visakhapatnam (considered to be the Second Party).**

AND TOGETHER HEREAFTER REFERRED AS PARTIES

Whereas the first party SAKSHAM is an NGO working for prevention of diasability and for rehabilitation of disabled people, CAMBA – Cornea Andhatv Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan and ABFV - Avoidable Blindness Free Villages are two ongoing projects of Saksham in 50 districts of India. SAKSHAM is a pan India non-for-profit society working in the fields of Visually Challenged, Hearing Challenged, Physically and Intellectually Challenged, Mental Illness, Blood Related Disorders and Leprosy affected patients.

And whereas the second party is an Educational Institution providing education in various courses and programmes including certificate courses U.G, P.G and PhD programmes in Engineering and Para Medical Courses. It has the vision and mission to impart quality education of International standards with a major focus on conducting skill development and outreach programmes. At present it is also conducting Under Graduate programmes in Paramedical Courses in Radiology, Anesthesia and Optometry.
