STELLAR HACKATHON

STELLAR MPC-TSS WALLET

1ST PRIZE - \$450

Our project is a secure digital wallet that helps users protect their crypto assets without relying on a single private key.

Instead of one person holding the entire key, the wallet uses threshold security, where multiple trusted parties each hold a small part of the key. A transaction can be approved only when a minimum number of parties agree, making it much safer against hacks, key loss, or mistakes.

The wallet works like a normal crypto wallet for the user, but behind the scenes it uses advanced cryptography to sign transactions securely. No single party ever has full control of the funds.

Our goal is to make strong security simple and usable, especially for individuals, teams, and small organizations who want safer crypto wallets without complex setups.

MINT2METAL

2ND PRIZE - \$400

Mint2Metal solves the problem of trust, access, and usability of physical silver in a digital-first world by bridging real, vaulted silver with blockchain-based ownership. Today, physical silver is difficult to verify, store, liquidate, or use for loans, while digital silver products lack transparency, true backing, and redemption.

Mint2Metal fixes this by minting tokens only after silver is securely deposited, enabling compliant access for Indian users and open Web3 participation for global users, allowing silver to be traded, used as collateral, and eventually redeemed—without breaking trust or regulatory boundaries.


